Thank you for your letter of 15 July concerning review of domiciliary midwives fees.

The remit that was passed at the Associations 1981 Conference has been referred to the Economic Welfare Committee for their consideration and action.

At their meeting of 14 May 1981 they decided to send a letter to the Minister of Health asking that fees for domiciliary midwives be reviewed on a regular basis. In addition he was also asked to carry out another review as the last one was done in October 1980.

The letter has been sent but no reply has been received as yet. No doubt there will be a reply before the Committee meets again and further action, if required, can be decided upon at that point.
