Thank you for your letter concerning the abuse of obstetrical technology in New Zealand.

Enclosed are some back issues of the NAPSAC News which might be helpful. We also publish several good books (see enclosed flyer). All of these books question current procedures and document, from the medical literature, their hazards. They also propose safe alternatives and also ~~document these~~ document these from scientific literature and original research.

NAPSAC has a member group in Australia. We have had correspondence with persons in New Zealand, but no group has as yet formed. One person we have corresponded with there is Jenny Hessel, Whakatane Parents Centre, ~~Whakatane~~ 18 Haig St., Whakatane, NZ. It is clear that New Zealand needs another voice in matters of maternity care. Otherwise, birth will be taken over by the dehumanized technologists. A battle rages in the U.S. at this time. I think we shall win. The medical establishment has power and money. But we have truth and, with education, will have public support. The medical establishment does not have public support, but they do have, in their favor, public passivity. By our educational conferences, books, and newsletters, we hope to wake the public up to the threat it faces from the medical establishment. We figure that even if only 5-10% of the public becomes truly informed, we shall win the battle for the public good in health care.
