Dear Mr. Dykstra,

I am writing to you on behalf of the Birth and Beyond Incorporated Society to request that we see you as soon as possible concerning the lease agreement for the property at 38 Owen Street.

A venture such as ours requires many arrangements to be made ahead of time e.g. fund raising occasions, staff appointments, ante natal preparation of women wishing to use the Centre. We naturally feel some diffidence about entering into such contracts when the lease agreement has not been legally made.

As you stated at our last meeting on May 12, it is the traditional lease agreement - but it will require Hospital Board approval.

We are now very concerned that these administrative procedures have not been set in motion.

I would appreciate hearing from you about an appointment to discuss these matters.
