AUCKLAND HOME BIRTH ASSOCIATION COMMITTEE MEETING Held at Marjet's on 18 Nov. 1991 at 9:30 a.m.

MATTERS ARISING:

1) CONFERENCE: Fundraising: \$1000 grant from Lotteries Board, \$2,300 from C.O.G.S. This pays for the venue. Film evenings not very well supported; too much work for the return. ASB has already allocated their money for this year, so none from them.

CONFERENCE: Planning: Session with Maori women came up with proposed programme: Friday at the marae; shared meal, welcome, after-dinner speech from Maori point of view.
