I refer to your letter of 6 October 1982 enclosing a copy of a letter of complaint to the Superintendent of National Womens Hospital regarding your brief admission there on 19 September 1982.

You have asked for my comments on the matters raised in that letter. Unfortunately I am not in a position to form an opinion on these matters until such time as I accept for investigation a formal complaint which falls within my jurisdiction and have had an opportunity to investigate it. In the present instance you have quite properly lodged your complaint directly with the Superintendent of the National Womens Hospital, Mr Hutchinson, and I assume from your letter that you have not yet received a reply.
