On the 8th of June I went for my appointment with the PPHN and
Obstetrician in Thames. But the PPHN was at a very important long
meeting??? ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ I was told by the Assistant PHN.
But at the same time, her secretary told me she was in the wards.
Mr Harrison, Obstetrician, had forgotten about it? but as I walked
into the Maternity Ward unexpected, the Staff Nurse introduced me
to him as he walked in. He came back later and told me Home
Deliveries were not on in Thames or anywhere in N.Z. If I could
deliver better as he then I could start Home Deliveries. If
anyone would start in Thames area, he would try to prevent it, or
else discontinue it as soon and as good as he could. I am not
prepared to start Home Deliveries in any place like that. Also he
told me, in Auckland six dead babies in the last six weeks
time? He had two nearly dead mothers to resuscitate and transfuse.

Delivery? So now I will not be coming to Auckland. I don't know
what will happen. I am staying in Hamilton in the meantime. I will
