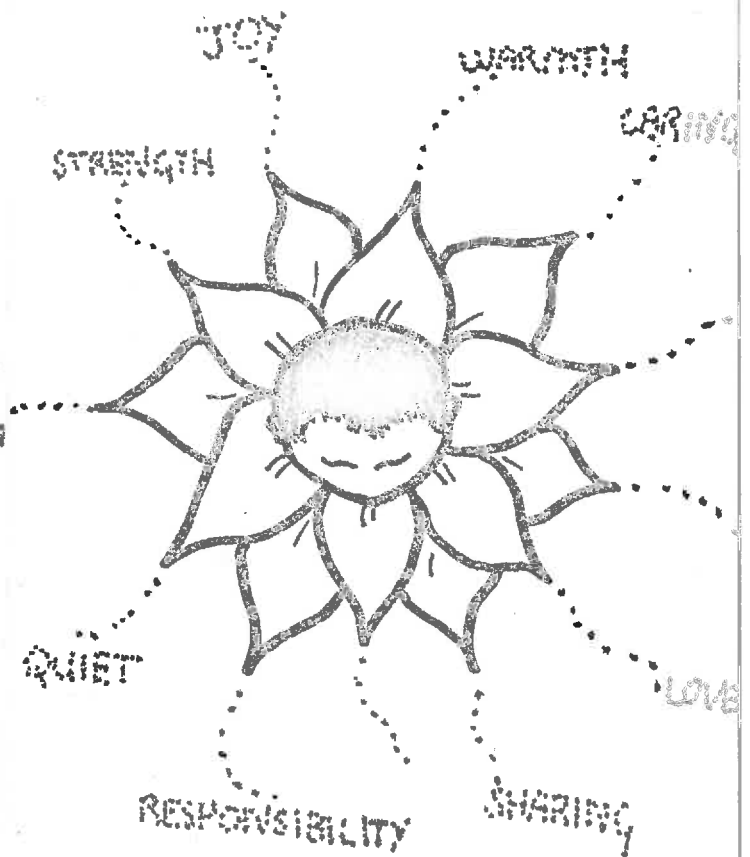
Refreshments will be available throughout the conference.
