

Hosted by - Thames/Hauraki Homebirth Assn. FRIDAY 4th - Sunday 6th Novembe

SITE - Te Rau Aroha Camp, Waihi Beach. The camp is on Seaforth Rd.
(As you arrive at the beach, turn right into Wilson Rd and proceed for
1½ miles towards Bowentown and Athenree).

DATE - Friday 4th November 5 pm. - to - Sunday 6th November 3pm.

The proximity to the beach and lay-out of the camp makes this an ideal venue for a family weekend.

The camp accommodation consists of -

The Jubilee Block - 8 rooms sleep 8 each in bunks,
1 double room (Concrete floors)
2 single rooms (Concrete floors)

4 caravan points are available and tents may be erected on the site.

All beds are supplied with Dunlopillow mattresses. Campers need to bring bedding, pillows, own plates, cups, cutlery and a tea towel - (please have named). A container of biscuits per family would also be very much appreciated. (for a.m. & p.m. teas and supper).

There are modern ablution and toilet facilities and 2 small laundries, washing machine etc. The telephone number of the camp is Waihi Beach - 45509, Mr Curson is the resident caretaker.

There is a recreation Hall and grassed areas for outside games - some named sports gear would be appreciated and quiet indoor games and don't forget your toddler activities.

Please remember that your children are your responsibility - we do intend having extra supervision of activities during session times and main speakers, but lets reflect the thought that Homebirths are a family affair!
