Thank you for sending us sample copies of your periodical:

AUCKLAND HOME BIRTH ASSOCIATION NEWSLETTER

for evaluation in terms of the legal deposit requirements of Section 64 of the Copyright Act 1962, as amended 1971.

Under the Act we are entitled to claim up to three copies of each issue, but our claim is frequently for a lesser number. It has become increasingly difficult for us to claim copies of every periodical, because our staff, space and funds are not large enough to handle the resulting flood of material.

Following a change in our collecting policy in consultation with the Alexander Turnbull Library, which maintains the national collection of New Zealand serials, we have developed new guidelines for claiming serials. In accordance with these guidelines, I wish to advise you that it will no longer be necessary for you to deposit copies of your publication, named above, with either the General Assembly Library or the Alexander Turnbull Library. This notification removes any obligation on your part to deposit copies, but the decision may be subject to review if the nature and scope of the publication change substantially.

The loss of records and archives through fire or accident is often a hindrance to future researchers, so it is desirable to maintain a set in an institution (eg. a local public library) as well as in the publisher's own archives. If you approach your local public library, pointing out that the National Library of New Zealand, which includes both General Assembly Library and the Turnbull Library, is no longer able to preserve your publication in this way, your library may be prepared to help.

Thank you for your assistance in forwarding sample copies for evaluation. Please retain this letter as a record of this transaction.
